Société de la Tour Eiffel completes the leasing of Domino BATIMENTS TERTILAIRES





The signature of two major leases completes the marketing of the company's 11,600 m² flagship office and retail project located Porte des Lilas on the north east borders of Paris.

The Centre des Monuments Nationaux have taken 3,964 m² on a 6/9-year lease and **Pôle Emploi** (State outplacement agency) 3,225 m² on a 3/6/9-year lease, joining paper distributor Antalis, an early tenant in the building.

Three ground floor retail units have been leased to Crédit Mutuel, NMPP (newsagents) and Espace Fleurs (florist).

The average office rent equates 290 €/m² pa, exclusive of staff restaurant and basement parkings. A full year's rent of 3.6 million Euros



for the property represents 5% of the company's recurring income.

These transactions put the level of lettings in the company's development portfolio delivered since the fourth quarter of 2008 (35,000 m²) at over 80%.

Managing Director Robert WATERLAND comments: "this excellent outcome, a first class tenant roster offering an exceptional spread of risk, represents a most satisfactory achivement in the context of a depressed letting market attesting to the qualities of the property which has a full HQE (green buliding) qualification".

Leasing agents were CBRE et BNP PARIBAS REAL ESATE for the offices and CUSHMAN & WAKEFIELD for the retail.
