Société de la Tour Eiffel, a leading player in office real estate in Greater Paris and high-potential regions, once again saw the quality and transparency of its financial and extra-financial communication rewarded with prizes at the EPRA Awards 2019.

It maintains its 3 green stars rating in the 2019 edition of the Global Real Estate Sustainability Benchmark (GRESB) survey and has witnessed a significant change in its score on the Environmental and Social aspects with an improvement of 7 points. This significant increase highlights the improvement in the performance of its assets in terms of waste production, water and energy consumption and CO2 emissions.

Société de la Tour Eiffel stands out by winning two awards. For the second year in a row, the real estate company was granted a Gold EPRA Award for its transparency in financial information and a Silver EPRA Award for the quality of its CSR information (in 2018 it was awarded the Bronze Award).

Société de la Tour Eiffel maintains its 3/5 green stars and obtains an overall score of 76/100 in the GRESB** ranking

Once again this year, the Société de la Tour Eiffel was awarded 3 out of 5 possible Green Stars in the GRESB survey for its actions in favour of the environment, society and governance. With a GRESB score of 76/100, its highest since its first participation in 2013, Société de la Tour Eiffel recorded a 7 point improvement compared to 2018.



"The GRESB survey, which is conducted once a year, evaluates the performance of participating real estate companies based on a series of environmental, social and governance (ESG) factors. Our participation confirms our voluntary and ambitious CSR strategy, allows us to validate our "Fundamentally Sustainable" positioning and place us high in the ranking compared to our peers" said Thomas Georgeon, Chief Executive Officer of the Société de la Tour Eiffel.
